

LOCAL RULES

1. Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1)

- (a) Out of Bounds areas are marked by white stakes with black tips.
- (b) All perimeter and boundary fences define "Out of Bounds". If a player's ball comes to rest against a fence relief is to be taken under penalty (Rule 28)

2. Water Hazards (Rule 26)

- (a) All water hazards are lateral water hazards, the margins of which are defined by either 1) red lines and/or red stakes 2) by the stone walls which may surround the hazard.
- (b) All bridges and pathways that cross a lateral water hazard are deemed to be part of that hazard.

3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2)

- (a) All distance marker posts and stone/rock course signage.
 - (b) **Fixed sprinkler heads** – Relief from interference by a fixed sprinkler head may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, 1) if a ball lies off the putting green, but not in a hazard and is on a sprinkler head or 2) if the sprinkler head is within two club lengths of the putting green and within two club lengths of the ball and it intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may take relief as follows:
 - The ball must be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lies that:
 - (a) is not nearer the hole; (b) avoids intervention; and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green (d) ball must be played from similar conditions.
- Note:** All other course objects are to be treated as 'Moveable Obstructions' as defined in Rule 24-1
- (c) **Staked Trees** – If a staked tree/shrub interferes with the player's stance or the area of the intended swing, the ball **must** be lifted without penalty, and dropped in accordance with the procedure prescribed in Rule 24-2b.
- Note:** The ball may be cleaned when lifted. The stakes are immovable obstructions.

- ### 4. Pathways
- A ball coming to rest on a constructed pathway may be lifted and dropped at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole, without penalty. However, a ball lying on any 'non-constructed' or natural pathway must be played as it lies.

5. Environmentally Sensitive Area (ESA)

The ESA's to the right of the 1st and 5th holes and to the left of 4th green are to be treated as **lateral water hazards** and are defined by red stakes.

Under no circumstances must any person enter the ESA to either play a shot or retrieve a ball.

6. Ground Under Repair (Rule 25)

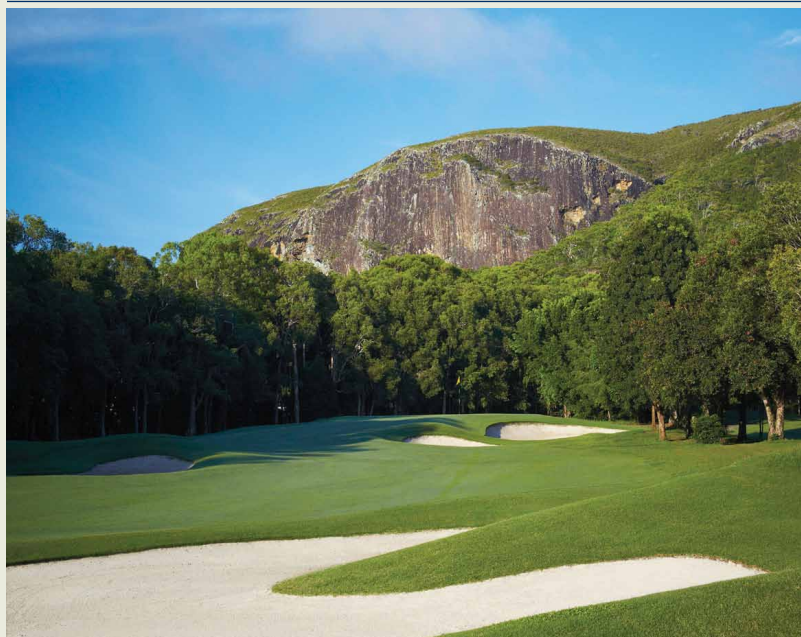
- (a) Those areas, the margins of which are defined by white lines or 'ground under repair' signage.
 - (b) All recently laid turf – compulsory lift and drop at all times.
 - (c) **Edging to Greens** – At various times the green keepers make a cutting at the edge of the greens to stop foreign grass from entering the putting surface. If a player's ball comes to rest in the 'cut', relief may be taken by **placing** the ball within 15cms – no nearer the hole.
- Note:** Garden beds are integral to the course - relief without penalty is **not** available – the ball must be played as it lies or be declared unplayable.

7. Use of Distance Devices (App 1-9)

- (a) Distance devices such as GPS based systems and laser rangefinders that measure distance only and not any other conditions that might affect a player's game such as wind and gradient are permitted for use in competition play.

- Distance marked on sprinkler heads is to the centre of the green
- Distance marker (wooden post with white ball at side of fairway) indicates 150 metres to the centre of green
- Yellow Flag = flag in front half of green / White Flag = flag in back half of green
